- 2. Therefore turn in prayer to your Lord and sacrifice (to Him only).
- 3. For he who hates you (O Muhammad صلى الله عليه وسلم), he will be cut off (from posterity and every good thing in this world and in the Hereafter).^[1]



In the Name of Allâh, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful.

- 1. Say: (O Muhammad صلى الله عليه وسلم to these Mushrikûn and Kafirûn): "O Al-Kâfirûn (disbelievers in Allâh, in His Oneness, in His Angels, in His Books, in His Messengers, in the Day of Resurrection, and in Al-Qadar.)!
 - 2. I worship not that which you worship,
 - 3. Nor will you worship that which I worship.
 - 4. And I shall not worship that which you are worshipping,
 - 5. Nor will you worship that which I worship.
- 6. To you be your religion, and to me my religion (Islâmic Monotheism)."



In the Name of Allâh, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful.

- 1. When there comes the Help of Allâh (to you, O Muhammad صلى الله عليه وسلم against your enemies) and the conquest (of Makkah).
- 2. And you see that the people enter Allâh's religion (Islâm) in crowds.
- 3. So glorify the Praises of your Lord, and ask His Forgiveness. Verily, He is the One Who Ever accepts the repentance and Who forgives.
